



**Q** ■ How do my students access their school email?

**A** ■ Go to [webmail.ebnet.org](http://webmail.ebnet.org)

Username: school username (do NOT include @ebnet.org)

Password: school password

**Q** ■ How do my students access their school Google Account?

**A** ■ Go to [drive.google.com](http://drive.google.com)

Username: school username@ebnet.org (Make sure to include @ebnet.org)

Password: Should be their school password (hint\* should be at least 8 characters long with at least one number. It may end in "16." Students were asked to write this down in their agenda on their birthday)

**Q** ■ What should my student do if they forgot their school password or google password?

**A** ■ If they forgot their school password, have them see a media specialist in the media center.

If they forgot their google password please have them email the help desk ([helpdesk@ebnet.org](mailto:helpdesk@ebnet.org)) with their school email requesting a google password reset.

**Q** ■ What other tools are my students using in the classroom?

**A** ■ Different teachers are using different platforms. Some of these include:

Moodle ([classroom.ebnet.org](http://classroom.ebnet.org)), Google Classroom ([classroom.google.com](http://classroom.google.com)), TeacherWeb ([teacherweb.com](http://teacherweb.com)), Remind ([remind.com](http://remind.com)), Noodletools ([noodletools.com](http://noodletools.com)), Turnitin ([turnitin.com](http://turnitin.com))

**Q** ■ What do I do if my student does not have access to a computer at home?

**A** ■ Students can borrow a netbook from the media center. They need to obtain a permission slip from the media center that needs to be signed by a parent or guardian before they can borrow a device.

**Q** ■ What do I do if my student does not have access to Microsoft Office?

**A** ■ Log in to your student's email account and locate the email dated 12/22/14 from Nick Latronica. Follow the instructions in the email to receive a free copy of Microsoft Office.

**Q** ■ Can my students access their school files from home?

**A** ■ Yes. Go to [ebdocs.ebnet.org](http://ebdocs.ebnet.org). Log in with your student's username & password.
